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What is this product?

Type

The product is a share class of the sub-fund HESPER FUND - GLOBAL SOLUTIONS, which is part of the HESPER FUND, SICAV (the "umbrella fund"), an open-ended investment company with variable capital (société d'investissement à capital variable - SICAV) of the umbrella type governed by Part I of the Luxembourg Law of 17 December 2010, as amended (Law of 2010), and thus qualifies as a UCITS. The assets and liabilities of all sub-funds are segregated by law.

Term

The sub-fund has no maturity date. Notwithstanding this provision, the sub-fund, in keeping with the articles of association, may be dissolved at any time by resolution of the management board / general meeting.

Objectives

Investment objective

The investment objective of the HESPER FUND - GLOBAL SOLUTIONS sub-fund is to achieve an appropriate increase in value in the currency of the sub-fund or share class. The sub-fund is actively managed. The composition of the portfolio is determined by the fund manager solely in accordance with the criteria laid down in the investment objectives / the investment policy, is regularly reviewed and, if necessary, adjusted. The sub-fund is not managed using an index as a benchmark.

Investment policy

The sub-fund invests its assets in all types of securities including shares, bonds, money market instruments, certificates and other structured products (e.g. reverse convertible bonds, warrant-linked bonds, convertible bonds), target funds, derivatives, liquid assets and fixed-term deposits. The sub-fund is a long/short multi-asset fund. Up to 20% of the net sub-fund assets may be invested indirectly in precious metals and commodities. More than 10% of the net sub-fund assets may be invested in target funds. The sub-fund

may employ financial instruments, the value of which is dependent on future prices of other assets ("derivatives") to hedge or increase assets.

In its investment decision-making process, the sub-fund takes into account not only financial aspects but also environmental and social aspects and the principles of good corporate governance (Environment, Social, Governance – ESG) in accordance with the ESG strategy of the management company. Article 8 of Regulation (EU) 2019/2088 and Article 6 of Regulation (EU) 2020/852 (EU taxonomy) apply to this sub-fund. ETHENEA Independent Investors S.A. has signed the UN PRI (UN-supported Principles for Responsible Investment). Dividend policy

Income generated by this product is distributed to investors.

Subscription and redemption

Investors may redeem their units on any banking day in Luxembourg, with the exception of 24 and 31 December. For details on return options, please refer to the section "How long should I hold the investment and can I withdraw money early?".

Intended retail investor

The fund is aimed at all types of investors who pursue the goal of asset accumulation or asset optimisation and wish to invest in the medium to long term. They should be able to bear losses up to the amount of the capital invested. The fund shall promote environmental and/or social characteristics in accordance with Article 8 of Regulation (EU) 2019/2088.

Depository

The fund's depository is DZ PRIVATBANK AG, Luxembourg branch, whose registered office is at 4, rue Thomas Edison, L-1445 Strassen, Luxembourg.

The risk indicator is based on the assumption that you will hold the product for 5 years.

The stress scenario shows what you might get back in extreme market circumstances.

Unfavourable scenario: this scenario occurs in the case of an investment between September 2022 and December 2025 with an suitable benchmark being used for the calculation, since fund data does not exist for the entire history.

Moderate scenario: this scenario occurs in the case of an investment between January 2019 and January 2024 with an suitable benchmark being used for the calculation, since fund data does not exist for the entire history.

Favourable scenario: this scenario occurs in the case of an investment between April 2016 and April 2021 with an suitable benchmark being used for the calculation, since fund data does not exist for the entire history.

What happens if ETHENEA Independent Investors S.A. is unable to pay out?

The default of ETHENEA Independent Investors S.A. has no direct impact on your payout, as the statutory regulation provides that in the event of the insolvency of ETHENEA Independent Investors S.A., the special assets do not become part of the insolvency estate, but are maintained independently.

What are the costs?

Costs over time

The tables show the amounts that are taken from your investment to cover different types of costs. These amounts depend on how much you invest, how long you hold the product and how well the product performs, if applicable. We have assumed:

- In the first year you would get back the amount that you invested (0% annual return). For the other holding periods we have assumed the product performs as shown in the moderate scenario.
- 10,000 EUR will be invested.

How long should I hold it and can I take money out early?

Due to the risk and return profile, we recommend a holding period of at least 5 years for this product.

However, you can return the product in accordance with the return procedures specified in the Sales Prospectus. An early return can significantly affect the risk and return profile. The redemption of shares may be suspended if exceptional circumstances appear to make this necessary, taking into account the interests of the shareholders, or limited if the shareholders' redemption requests reach a predefined threshold above which said requests can no longer be executed in the interests of the shareholders as a whole. The redemption period may be extended if this is necessary in the interests of the shareholders. The Management Company may separate certain assets whose economic or legal characteristics have changed significantly or become unsafe due to exceptional circumstances from the other assets of the Fund.
